TEAM CENTER: ENTER TEAMS AND REGISTER MENTORS

If you haven't already done so, log into the online Team Center (www.dfwfuturecity.org/teamcenter.html) and enter your teams ... you will need to do this before you can submit any deliverables. And, please tell your team mentors to also enroll in the Team Center. This will give these volunteers access to the team information and the ability to manage teams and deliverables.

ALSO NOTE: there is a "Partial Participation" option for all teams. This means you do not have to submit all the deliverables. You will still be eligible to display and present your model and be considered for some of the special awards. This way, you will get most of the benefit and experience of the Future City program.

SIMCITY DOWNLOADS AND INSTALLATION

All of you should have downloaded the SimCity. If you are installing the program on a school computer, there may be a problem with the school firewalls. Future City has some suggestions for working around the firewall (see http://futurecity.org/resources and filter on "SimCity"). Also, please feel free to have your IT people give me a call for ideas and workarounds.

VIRTUAL CITY SLIDESHOW DELIVERABLE - INITIAL DUE DATE 2 DECEMBER

Initial deadline for the slideshow deliverable is 2 December. <u>Late submissions</u> of the slide show are acceptable through 19 December with a small penalty. (See the complete NTX regional schedule at www.dfwfuturecity.org/team sched.html.)

Upload the pdf file through the team center.
