PRELIMINARY ROUND Q&A –29 Jan, 9am-1pm. This portion of the competition will be conducted online via Zoom in a manner similar to last year. Each team will be scheduled a single session with a panel of judges. The sessions will be 30 minutes –first the judges will view the team's video presentation (not scoring, but becoming familiar with city design), then the team and judges will introduce themselves, followed by Q&A for 10 minutes, and then the team leaves and the judges enter their scores. I will be sending you more detailed information and your scheduled time(s) next week.
