If you haven't already done so, bookmark the NTX FCC website: <a href="https://www.dfwfuturecity.org/teamcenter.html">www.dfwfuturecity.org/teamcenter.html</a> for regional information and resources you won't find on the national site. Check out the **Schedule** and **List of Organizations** registered for this year. We have more than 50 schools and organizations signed up for 2019-20.

## **ENTER TEAM INFORMATION INTO TEAMCENTER**

ASAP please (if you haven't already done so) – enter your team information into the online system. It will help us with facility planning. Just log in and "create" your teams. Note: team names must be unique – you will get an error message if the team name has already been used. However, feel free to enter a temporary name/placeholder – you can change it later.

You will need to have the teams enrolled before you can upload any files – so don't wait until the last minute.

Also, please tell your mentors to register as well. <a href="https://secure.futurecity.org/NorthTX/MentorBin/Mentor/Enroll">https://secure.futurecity.org/NorthTX/MentorBin/Mentor/Enroll</a>. We will include them in the distribution for Future City information and updates.

## SIMCITY DOWNLOADS AND INSTALLATION

All of you should have downloaded the SimCity. If you are installing the program on a school computer, there may be a problem with the school firewalls. Future City has some suggestions for working around the firewall (see <a href="http://futurecity.org/resources">http://futurecity.org/resources</a> and filter on "SimCity"). Also, please feel free to have your IT people give me a call for ideas and workarounds.

## **VIRTUAL CITY SLIDESHOW – DUE 20 NOVEMBER**

Initial deadline for the slideshow deliverable is 20 November. Late submissions of the slide show are acceptable through 6 December with a small penalty. (See the complete NTX regional schedule at <a href="https://www.dfwfuturecity.org/team\_sched.html">www.dfwfuturecity.org/team\_sched.html</a>.)

Upload the pdf file through the team center.

SPECIAL NOTE ON SCREENSHOTS: If you find that your screenshots don't include the tools and information items along the bottom of the screen, check the "Options" menu under the "Settings" tab. Make sure the item "turn off UI when taking screenshots" is not checked.

The City Essay is the next deliverable, due on 9 December.
