FCC Jr. Update: Essay last call, Model info

LAST DATE TO SUBMIT ESSAY IS 20 DECEMBER

Submit your essay via the Team Center: www.dfwfuturecity.org/team_junior.html. Note: you aren't disqualified if you don't submit the essay ... you can still complete the model and show it at UT Arlington. Just go into the Team Center and edit your teams to show "partial participation."

MODELS

If you haven't already done so, download the complete model rules and rubrics at: <http://www.dfwfuturecity.org/FCJrModelReq20.pdf>. Then, check out the information at www.dfwfuturecity.org/team_junior.html for resources you can use to plan and build your models. The models for the junior competition are to illustrate your solution for "Clean Water: Tap into Tomorrow" (essay). Maximum size for the model is 25" (w) x 36" (l) x 20"(h).

Don't forget to keep track of your expenses for building the model. You will need to document them on the Expense Form. Keep your receipts to include with the form. Each team can spend up to a maximum of \$50 on their model.

Models will be due on 25 January. You will be delivering them to UT Arlington, Nedderman Hall where we will be holding the NTX Regional Future City Competition. This will give you/your teams an opportunity to see what the middle schoolers have designed.

I will get you information on the schedule and model judging last month and I will update the website with the details shortly. In the meantime, if you have any questions, please do not hesitate to contact me.
